Alternate Vice Chair Kristine Cassie: Representing the rural area of Lethbridge County including Coalhurst, Nobleford and Barons.

Lorelei Bexte: Representing a rural area in Vulcan County east of Highway 23/24 that includes the communities of Arrowwood, Milo, and Champion, as well as the communities served by Calgary Christian School, Horizon Elementary School and Menno Simons Christian School, all of Calgary.

Sharon Rutledge: Representing the rural area at the south end of Lethbridge County, outside the City of Lethbridge and Town of Coaldale.

Don Boras: Representing Picture Butte and surrounding area, as well as Iron Springs and the communities served by Calgary Islamic Schools and Master's Academy & College, all of Calgary.
