Jana read the minutes from the January 23, 2024 meeting. No errors or omissions, adopted as read.

Treasurer Report

Mrs. Bernie Kirk (Grades 1-3, 4-6 Science) – Math - basic fact review grade 1. Grade 2-3 expressions. Grade 3 multiplication. LA research project on unusual animals. Parents will be invited to come view presentations with popcorn when done. Social - Landforms. Science Grades 4-6 presenting Aliens. Science - starting CSI unit Grade 6, Grade 4-5 lights and shadows (students will need to bring flashlights). Scientists in schools came. Buildings with grade 1-3, Lights and shadows with grades 4-6.

Ms. Quincy Smith (Grades 4-6 LA & Social, 7-9 LA & Social, Learning Support Teacher) – LA grade 4-6 – write it right, words their way, and handwriting each day. LA Gr 7-9 Currently reading Number the Stars and use it to write an essay when done. Grade 4-5 Social – first peoples (NEED SHOE BOXES). Grade 6 Social - Local government. Gr 9 social – different economies, supply & demand.

Mrs. Sara Woofenden (Math 4-9, Jr. high Science, Health, PE) – Jr high math algebraic expressions, 4-6 math – starting division unit, long division and other methods of solving division. PE curling 2 days per week, should be doing curling games next week and also doing gymnastics when not curling. Health – grade 4-9 sex education. Grade 1-3 growth of the human body.

Mr. Dakota Mattson (Principal, Jr. high sciences, Options) - Grade 7-8 heat and temperature unit.
Grade 9 – electricity, bringing in algebra, building and manipulating circuits. Then chemistry.
Hailey Stewart (Milo Alphabets Kindergarten) – just starting working on money unit tying money to math, social, etc. Some skip counting, eg counting by 5. Leprechaun coming. Building things for leprechaun traps. Reading simple sentences. Pre-K starting full days in March on Thursdays to try it and see how students do.

Board report. Meeting needs of students post covid (mental health, more anxiety, etc.), staff training. Mental Health Grant ends at the end of this school year. Hopefully the government continues the grant. Technology services – severely underfunded, board is adding \$11,000 per

- Alberta Education Assurance Measures Survey. Alberta Education has sent an access code to you in the mail for parents to complete. All grades 4-9 parents should have got a code. All students in Grades 4-9 will also complete the survey in school. When answering the questions, please do not say I don't know. It marks it a negative against the school and inaccurate data. Use N/A instead or can contact the school if have questions. Closes March 1.
- 2. EA Hiring
 - Position for a temporary EA (after February break until end of school year). Splitting between junior high and grades 1-3. 25-26 hours per week. Accepted by Robin Weins Monday, Tues, Wed and Thur morning.
 - Advertising for Full-time EA for Junior High. Jordan's Principal grant got by Ms. Smith.
- 3. **4 day school week continuation vote.** Ballots handed out to parents who attended meeting. Count done by Grant Turner and Celia Lahd. Need 65% support to continue with 4 day school week. To be clear, the school and School Council are both in full support of our 4-day week schedule. This schedule is a long-standing part of our community that we are proud of, dating back to 1993. We are undergoing this process to ensure the 4-day schedule approved follows proper procedures expected by Palliser School Division and Alberta Education. Ballots are due March 14.

- a) Fundraising for 2026 Marine Biology Trip spring 2026– Current Grade 5, 6 & 7. Cash calendar tickets please get sold ASAP and get tickets and money back to the school or post office. Cash calendar draw starts March 1.
