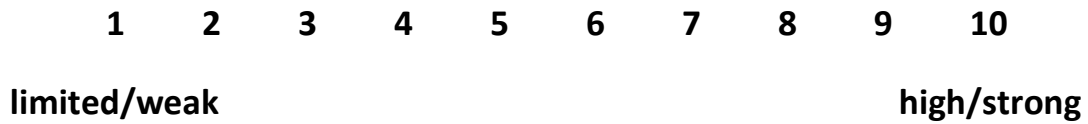


## Background:

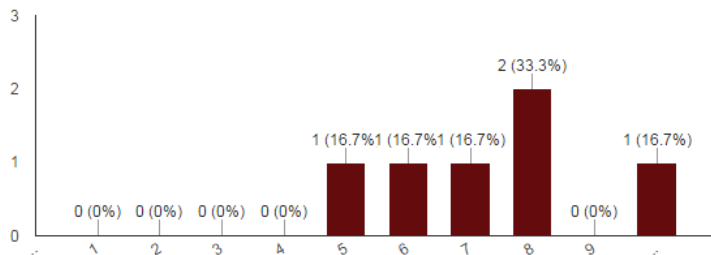
***This data will be used to inform staff and parents, to encourage meaningful conversations about learning, and to help us achieve greater success as a supportive school community.***

The questions used a 10 point scale:

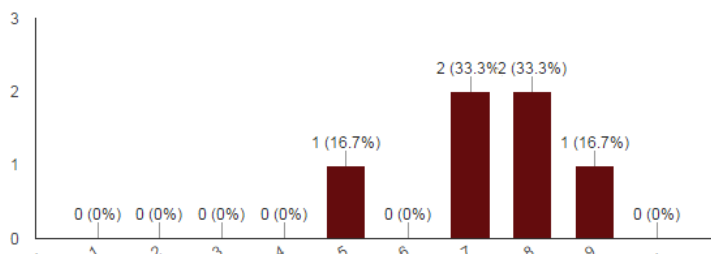


## STAFF Perspective:

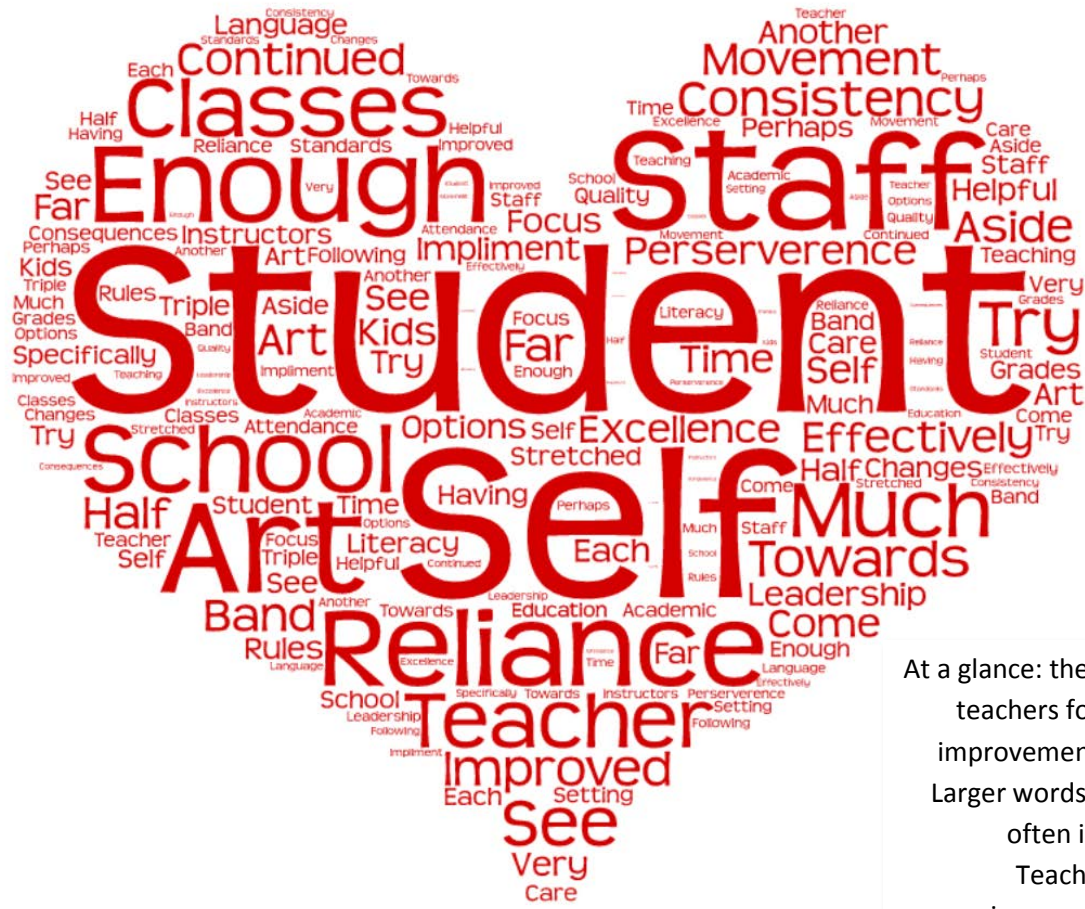
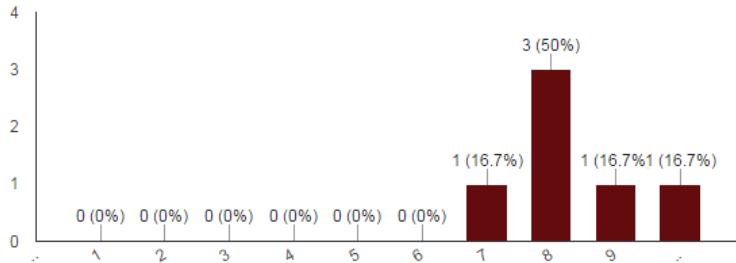


How would you rate the quality of education at the school? This includes classroom environment, assessment, clear expectations and learning achievement.

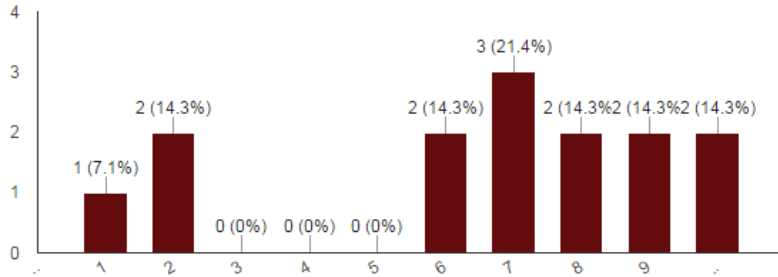

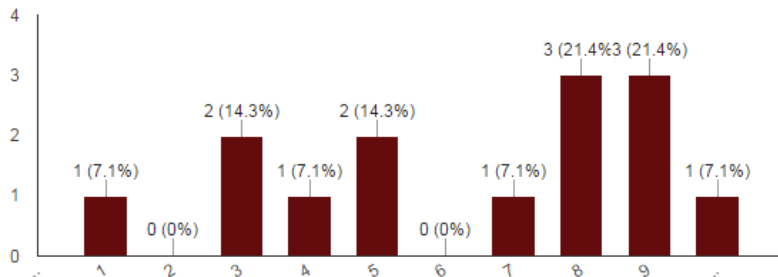
How would you rate the level of learning opportunities the school has - (options and classes, various types of learning, learning support for struggling students)

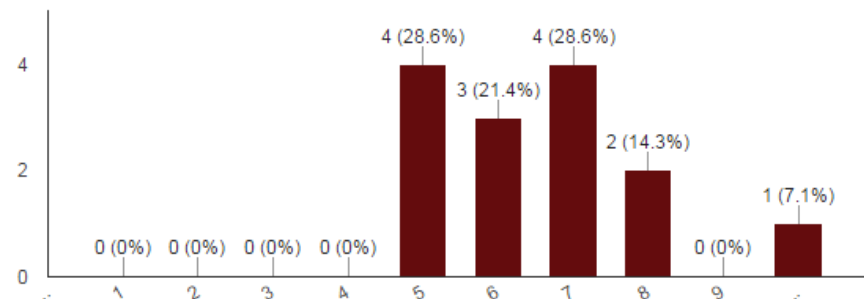
How would you rate the quality of education at the school? This includes classroom environment, assessment, clear expectations and learning achievement.

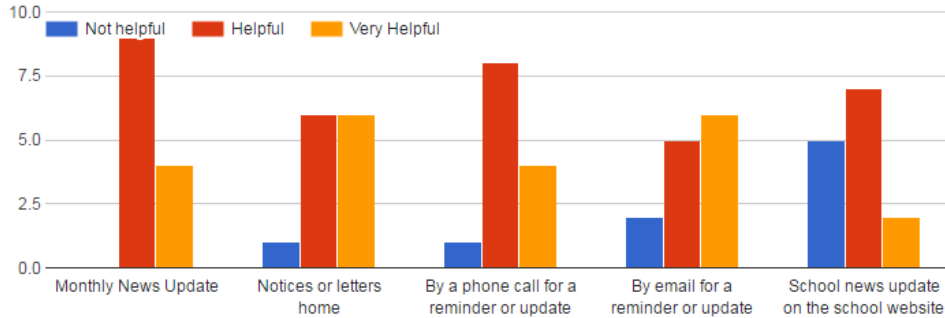


How would you rate the level of communication this year in the school?

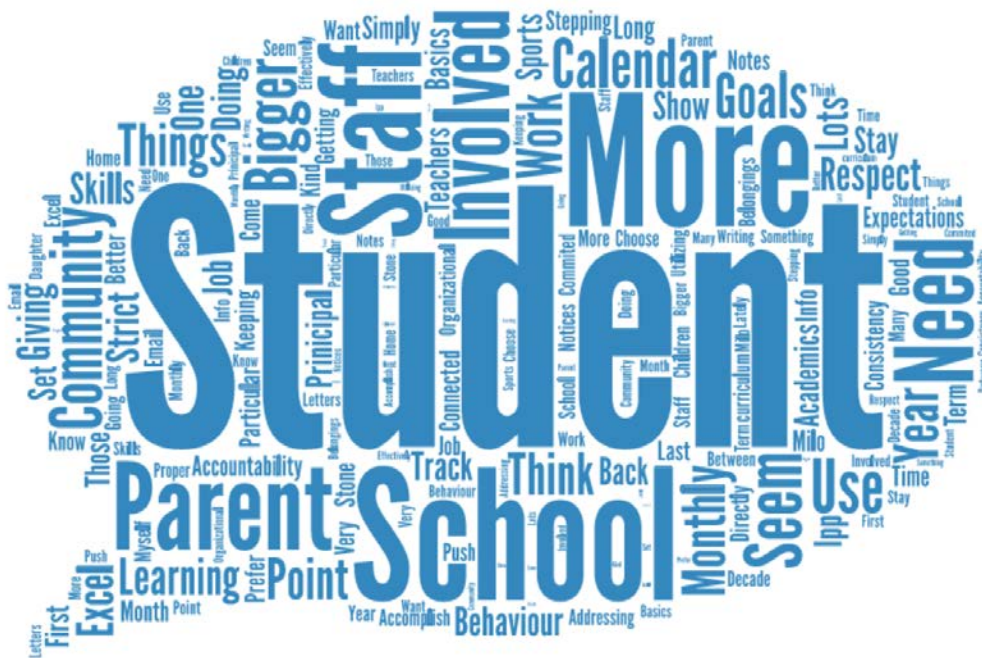
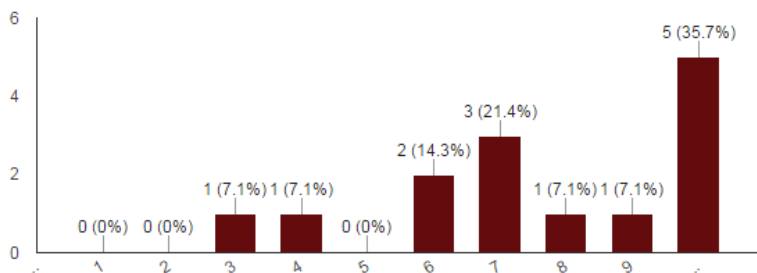

In what ways do you prefer communication?



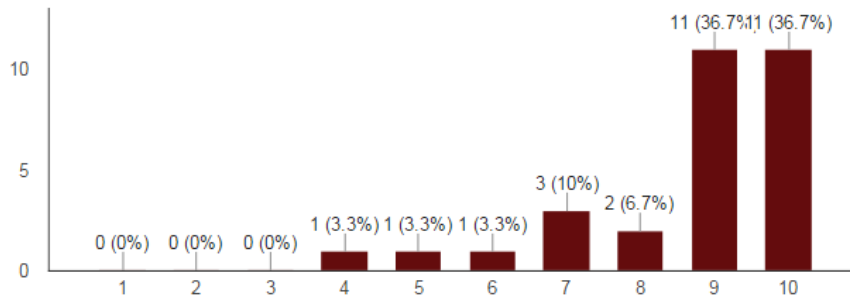
How well do you think the school does in working to improve the school, set goals and create changes for growth?

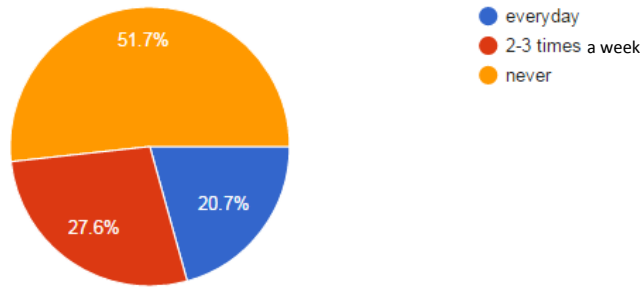

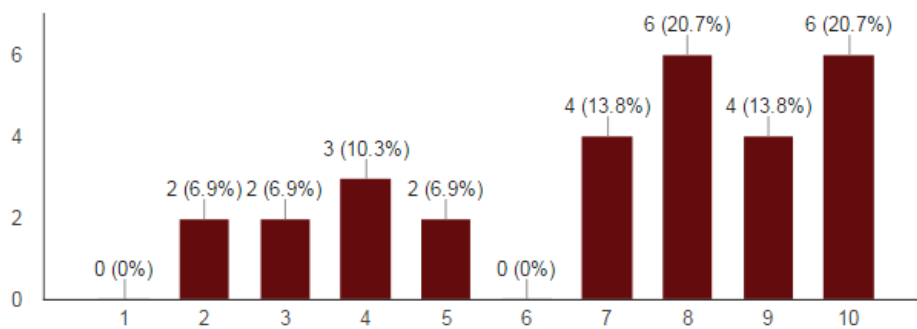
How much do you feel the school is safe and caring? (30 responses)



How often do you miss breakfast in the morning before school? (29 responses)

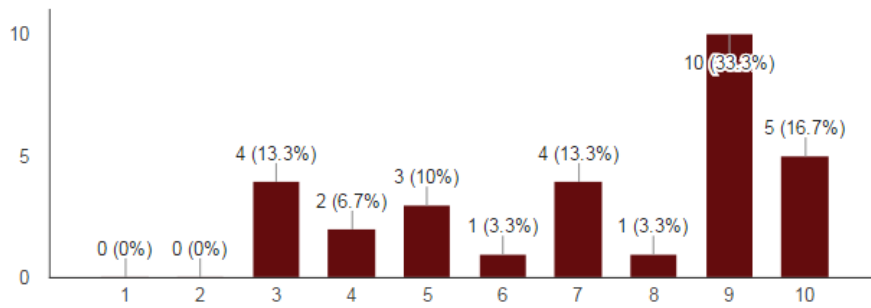


How much do you feel inspired to be a lifelong learner at school? (29 responses)



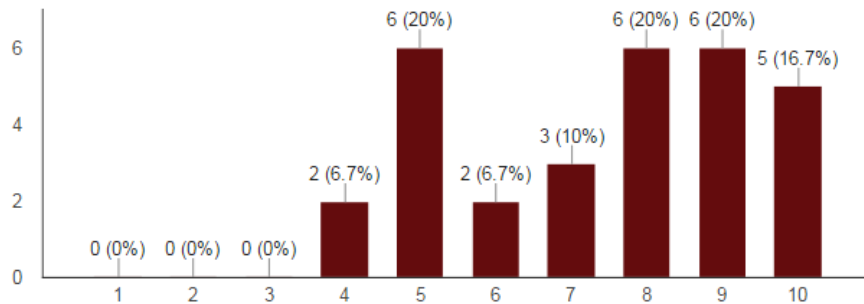
How would you rate the level of learning opportunities the school has - (options and classes, various types of learning, learning support if you are struggling)

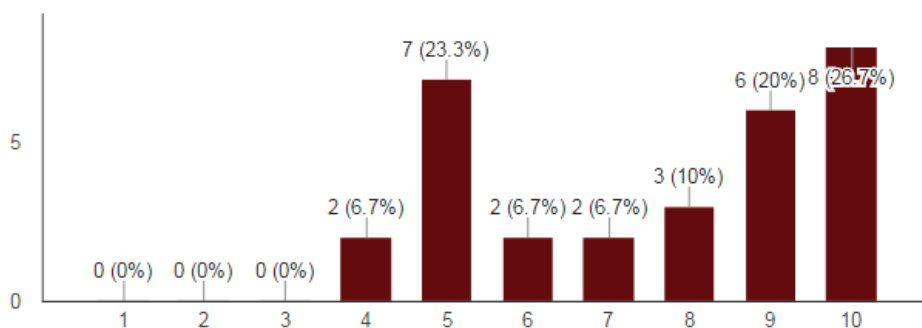
How would you rate the quality of education at the school? This includes classroom environment, assessment, clear expectations and learning achievement.

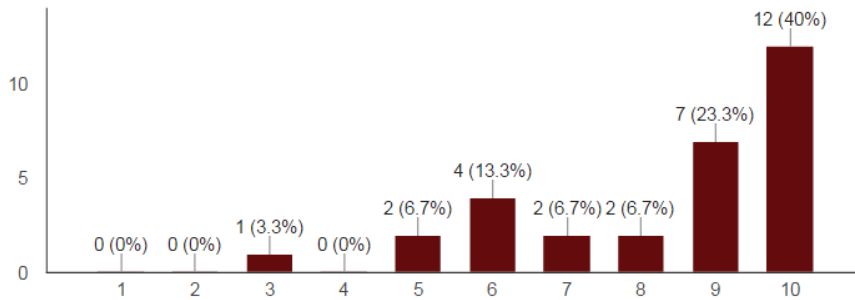
