#### **School Foundation Treasurer Report**

General Account:

Casino Account:

- Paid Palliser for busing \$422 to science centre field trip on May 21
- Outstanding Funding requests:
  - Casino funds available after outstanding requests less Early Literacy Budget & Marine Biology portion = \$9,218.54
