### **School Foundation Treasurer Report**

General Account:

- Chequing \$6,489.02
- GIC's \$47,924.41

\$765.18 paid June 30 to Milo School for academic achievement and dedication & determination award plaques.

#### Casino Account:

- Chequing \$2,689.19
- GIC's \$10,000.00
  - Paid June 25 Blackfoot Crossing \$943.95 for field trip
  - o Paid June 30 \$1500 donation to Milo Alphabets Kindergarten
  - o Paid July 23 Casino cash cage advisor fees of \$2,350.95 (which was reimbursed by AGLC)
  - Paid Sept 4 Frances Thompson \$50 for one used plasma car that she found for sale
  - Paid Sept 4 Frances Thompson \$1562.67 for early literacy hours
- Outstanding Funding requests:
  - Casino funds available = \$8,169.19 (\$4520 is Marine Biology portion from cash calendar raffle)
  - Per conversation with AGLC, we have until November 22, 2024 to spend the \$8,000+ in casino funds. Do not need to ask for an extension of funds as long as you have less than \$10,000 in your account before your casino (which was in July). Raffle money in the casino account, have 3 years from raffle date to spend money.
  - More AGLC casino money should be coming in October. Estimating over \$50,000.
  - Will need to make a budget for early literacy hours for 2024/2025 next meeting.
  - Tyrell Museum Field trip expenses from last year will ask Tammy Lahd if there are any bills to pay.
- New Funding requests:
  - $\circ$  App #271 cooling osculating fans for classrooms. 4 = \$330 ish.
  - App #271 Analogue/Digital Clocks for classrooms amazon for library, art room, grade 1-3 room, Junior high room (blue tooth speaker clock) 3 clocks and bluetooth speaker clock = \$190 ish.
  - Jana motioned to get 5 fans, and 6 clocks digital/analogue combination clocks. Clocks can be paid for by casino funds, fans will have to be paid for with general funds. Jackie and Maruissa seconded the motion, Carried.
